



Our mission in the church and to the world around us

I am happy to update that we have completed the initial phase of our strategic planning. Personally, I am extremely excited to see how God will lead Charis into the next few years. I see how all of us can have a part to play as a disciple, as a family in the church and in the community around us. We will be sharing more about this renewed mission over the pulpit in the first few months of 2025, but let me give everyone a preview: There are 3 major themes.

First, it is all about learning to abide in Christ as He abides in us. What practical steps can we take to truly put Jesus in the centre of our lives? Second, we will press on in discipleship and disciple-making. We are equipping our Zone Leaders and Small Group Leaders to lead accountable communities, which are essential in helping us pursue holiness. If you are not yet part of an accountable community, we want to help you find one. Lastly, we need to actively participate in God's work in the community – to be an attractive community. That is the church's mission in this world. I hope you are fired up and eager to find out more.

Let me encourage everyone that our focus on disciple-making and being an attractive community has not changed – and we are already making good progress. Over the past few months, we have made our presence felt in the community. During our Health Screening event with AIC (Agency for Integrated Care), we welcomed 55 elderly individuals into our church for the first time. Speaking to some of them, I discovered that they live nearby but did not know about Charis. Now, they know, and we have blessed them in tangible ways! What a wonderful testimony!

We have also organised two mission trips in August and October to the newly introduced mission field at Kota Tinggi, with 29 members participating in these trips. Many of them have never been on a mission trip before! There is one more trip coming in December, so if you are interested, please approach the Missions Committee. The Kota Tinggi mission field is a great way to get involved in missions even if you can only commit one weekend. Lastly, we are organising a church-wide evangelistic event on 21st December, which you'll hear more about later. Do invite your family and friends to celebrate Christmas at Charis!





I had the privilege of visiting Care Haven twice—first on August 3 and again on October 5, 2024. Both visits were incredibly humbling. The moment we stepped in, the kids welcomed us with open arms and big smiles, making us feel right at home. I was struck by how well-behaved they were—they treated one another with such respect and care. Despite some not having formal education, they contributed to the running of the home by serving guests, farming, cooking, doing laundry, and cleaning. I love the peaceful and well-kept place.

Pastor Meizhen, who runs Care Haven, truly impressed me. Her love and dedication to the children is most inspiring. She teaches them the Bible, how to pray and worship God. The quality of their bakes was excellent—beautifully

packaged and professionally made. Yums!

During my second visit, a few of us gave a simple career awareness talk to the older kids. Our goal was to connect with them, reminding them they are fearfully and wonderfully made by God, with a bright future ahead if they choose to shape it. We aimed to meet them where they were, though I later realized the content could be further simplified (a good learning for next time!).

What stood out to me most is the importance of consistent, meaningful engagement. One-on-one conversations, prayer, and encouragement are vital. As we minister to the kids, we were in turn so incredibly ministered to by them!

Tan Chien Hui:

During my recent visit to Care Haven, I was moved by how full of life and curiosity the children were. Their energy was contagious, and it was a joy to be around them, watching their excitement over simple games and conversations. They embraced every moment with enthusiasm, and one of the most endearing moments was when several of them remembered my name right away.

What impressed me most was their remarkable discipline and independence. Despite their young age, they managed their daily routines with maturity, taking responsibility for themselves and helping each other without hesitation. Yet, despite their independence, they clearly loved company and thrived in the presence of others, welcoming us with open arms. This visit reminded me of how Jesus found love and joy in the company of children, valuing their innocence and openness. My time with them was a powerful reminder of how much we can learn from the pure hearts of children.

Our mission trip to Care Haven has been a very heart warming one. The kids were God-centered, responsible from a young age and love one another as a family. The kids had so little, yet always thankful and joyful. I am often reminded how we should learn to be thankful and joyful in all circumstances. 
